Three assessments for theory cum studio courses each carrying 100 marks shall be conducted by the Department. At least one should be in the form of a test in the lines of the End Semester Examination and the other two assessments can be in the form of assignments, drawing plates, models, etc. The total marks obtained in all the assessments put together out of 300, shall be reduced to a weightage of 50 marks and rounded to nearest integer.

If a student fails to secure a pass in studio examinations of courses comprising of Architectural Design / Planning Project and Thesis, the student shall resubmit the work with improvements within 30 days of the declaration of results and appear for a Viva-Voce supplementary examination. However, the internal assessment marks obtained by the candidate shall be retained and valid for the considered Viva-Voce supplementary examination.

In such a case where the candidate fails to pass the supplementary Viva-Voce examination conducted, the student shall not take the end semester examination and Viva Voce examination for the courses of that semester. The student shall repeat the course in which he fails to secure a pass when the course when it is offered next secure fresh internal submit assessment and Architectural Design, Planning Project and Thesis as in the case of a regular student.

If any other professional elective or open elective course is opted by the candidate, the previous registration is cancelled and henceforth it is to considered as new elective professional or open elective course. The candidate has to register and attend the classes, earn the continuous assessment marks, fulfill the attendance requirements as per Clause 7 and the end semester appear examination.

11.1.5 If a student fails to secure a pass in examinations of studio courses comprising of Architectural Design / Planning Project and Thesis, the student shall resubmit the work with improvements within 30 days of the declaration of results and appear for supplementary Viva-Voce examination. However, the internal assessment marks obtained by the candidate shall be retained and the considered valid for Viva-Voce supplementary examination.

> In such a case where the candidate fails to the pass Viva-Voce supplementary the examination conducted. student shall not take the end semester examination and Viva Voce examination for the courses of that semester. The student shall repeat the course in which he fails to secure a pass when the course when it is offered next secure fresh internal assessment and submit the Architectural Design, Planning Project and Thesis as in the case of a regular student.
