<b>CLAUSE 4 STRUCTURE OF THE PROGRAMMES</b>	<b>CLAUSE 4 STRUCTURE OF THE PROGRAMMES</b> <b>4.7</b> One credit courses shall be offered by the Department with the prior approval from Centre for Academic Courses. Details of the syllabus, Time Table and faculty may be sent to the Centre for Academic Courses after approval from the Department Consultative Committee. The credits earned through the one credit courses shall be over and above the minimum credit requirement prescribed in the curriculum. The students shall take one credit courses offered in other Departments with the permission of HOD of offering Department.
<b>CLAUSE 10 PROCEDURES FOR AWARDING MARKS FOR INTERNAL ASSESSMENT (IA)</b> <b>10.5</b> Every teacher is required to maintain an 'ATTENDANCE AND ASSESSMENT RECORD' for every semester which consists of attendance marked in each lecture or practical or project work class, the test marks and the record of class work (topics covered), separately for each course handled by the teacher. This should be submitted to the Head of the Department periodically (at least three times in a semester) for checking the syllabus coverage and the records of	<b>CLAUSE 10 PROCEDURES FOR AWARDING MARKS FOR INTERNAL ASSESSMENT (IA)</b> <b>10.5</b> Assessment for one credit course The one credit course shall carry 100 marks and shall be evaluated through <b>internal assessments only</b> . Two Assessments shall be conducted during the semester by the Department concerned. The total marks obtained in the tests shall be reduced to 100 marks and rounded to the nearest integer. The Head of the Department may identify a faculty member as coordinator for the course. A committee consisting of the staff handling the course (if available), coordinator, Class Committee

The other grades U, W, SA <b>will not figure in the mark sheet.</b></p>
